We are also providing dinner for the Alabama Head Injury Foundation, which is assisting one of the WellHouse graduates. In addition, we provided approximately \$1,800 in help

with tuition and books for a foster child who aged out of the foster care system. This student had earned a partial scholarship to the University of South Alabama.

To fund these and our other projects, we cook and freeze meals, soups, and breakfast items, and then make those items available to church members and friends for donations. Our new items will include Heavenly Delight, Red Beans and Rice with Conecuh Sausage, and Buffalo Chicken Dip. 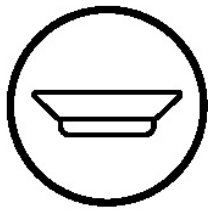

Remaining receipts required to achieve annual budget: \$1,078,887.09



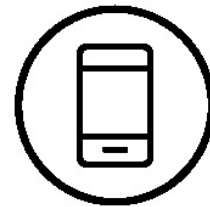
