

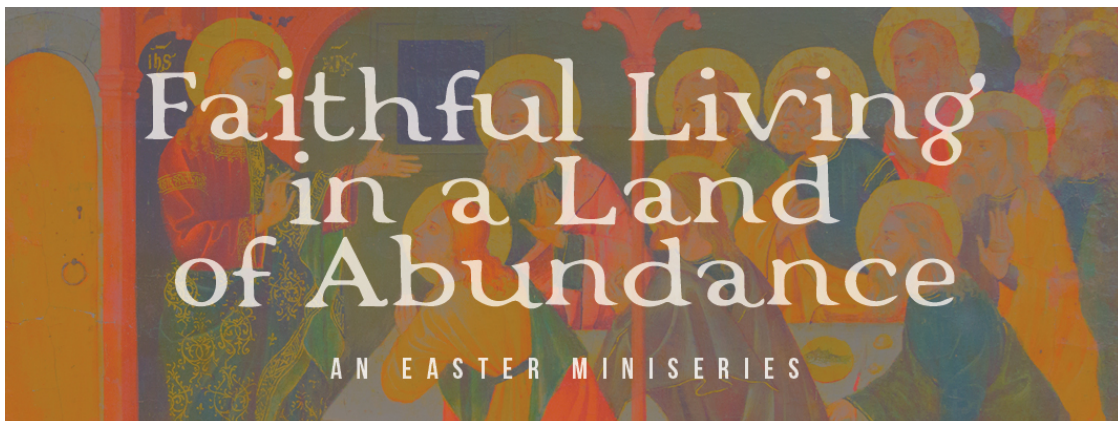

### **Graduate Information Needed Deadline: Monday, April 27**

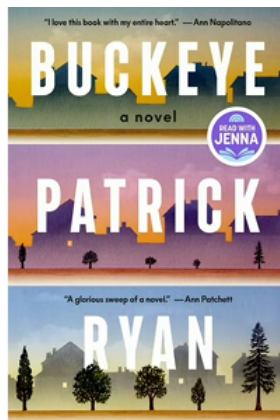

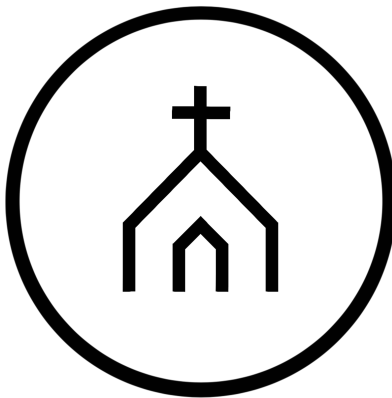

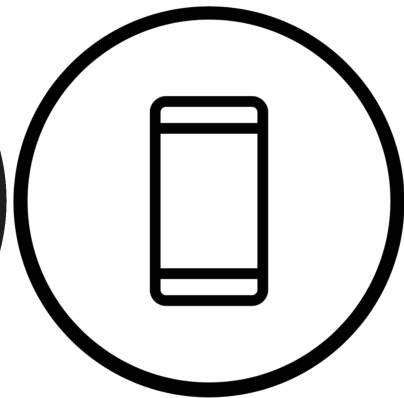
