10/40 Connections exists to cast hope to unreached peoples so that they hear, experience, and multiply the good news of Jesus. They focus on moving the message and hope of Jesus to the hard places, making unreached peoples the priority. Their work is focused in the 10/40 Window, the area of the world between 10 to 40 degrees North latitude marking the boundary of the least evangelized region of earth. They connect, equip, and engage in the following areas: at-risk children, biblical justice, grassroots church planting, relevant teaching, and strategic collaboration.

Here are some prayer requests that the founders of 1040 Connections shared with their prayer supporters:

- Pray for 10/40's new website launch which will help equip front-line church planters and unify them for the Great Commission.
 - Pray for spiritual protection from all attacks and for unity aiming toward our common goal.
 - Ask God to provide divine connections and open doors for our indigenous partners and cross-cultural workers to share the hope they have found in Christ.
 - Ask God to offer protection to our indigenous partners, staff, and cross-cultural workers from physical harm and spiritual attack.
 - Ask God to enable 10/40 staff, indigenous partners, and cross-cultural workers not to grow weary in doing good, for their love not to grow cold, and for them to maintain trust in the God of all hope in a difficult world.



addressed in last month's article. As a reminder, if you do not choose a purpose, the Board of the Foundation will determine how to allocate your gift.


