Men and Women's Growth Group Opportunities

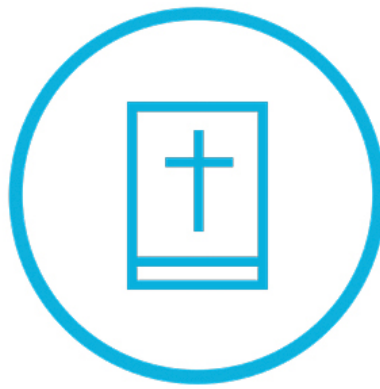
