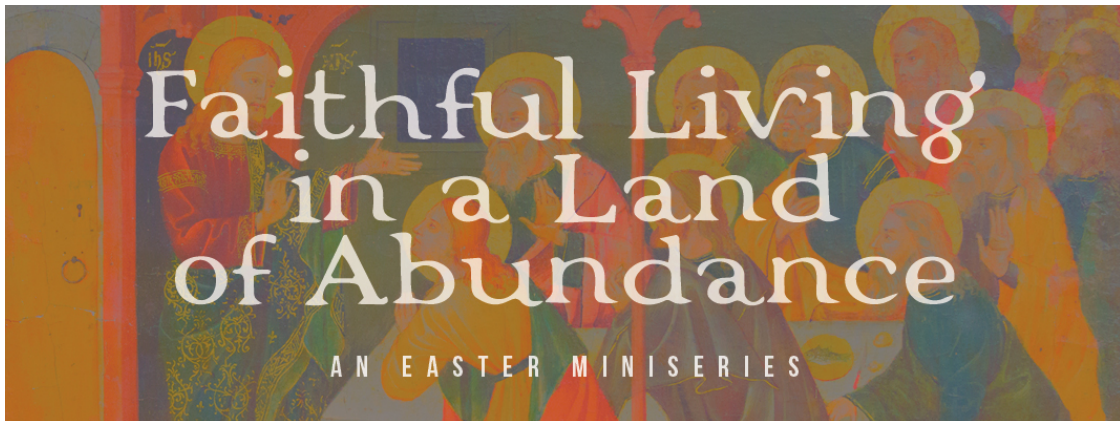

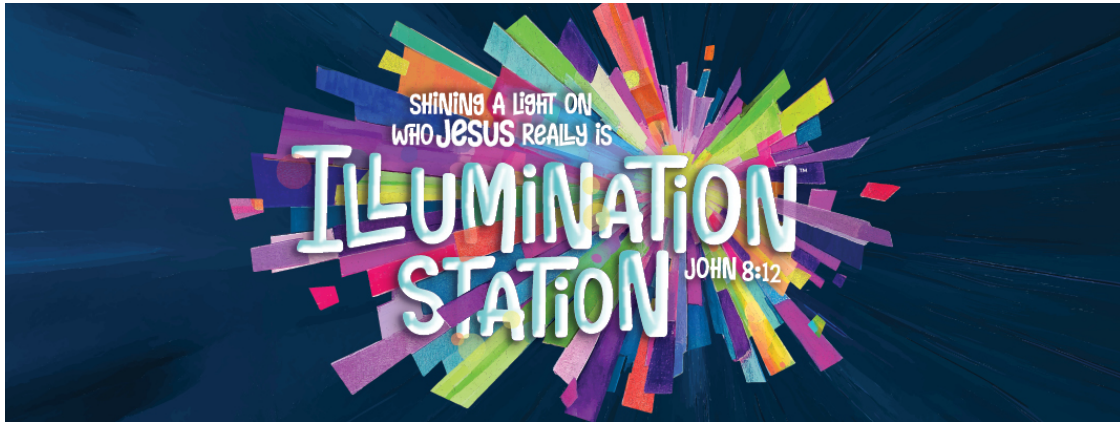
Wednesday night dinner, missions and music for kids, and growth groups for adults will resume on September 2, 2026.

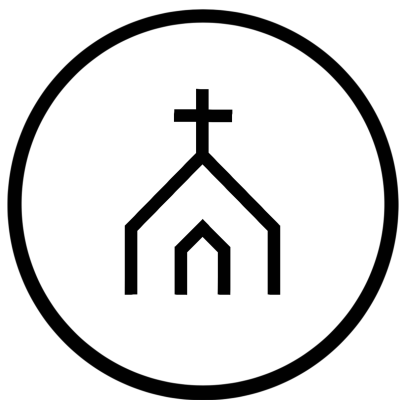

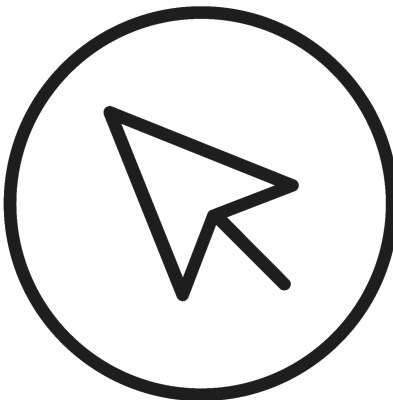

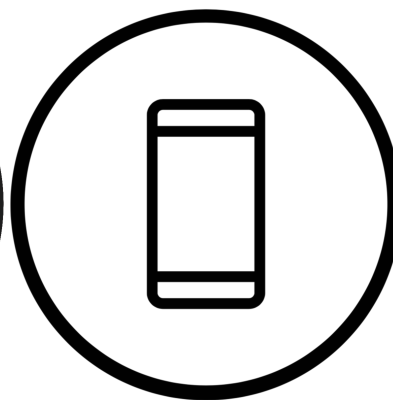
