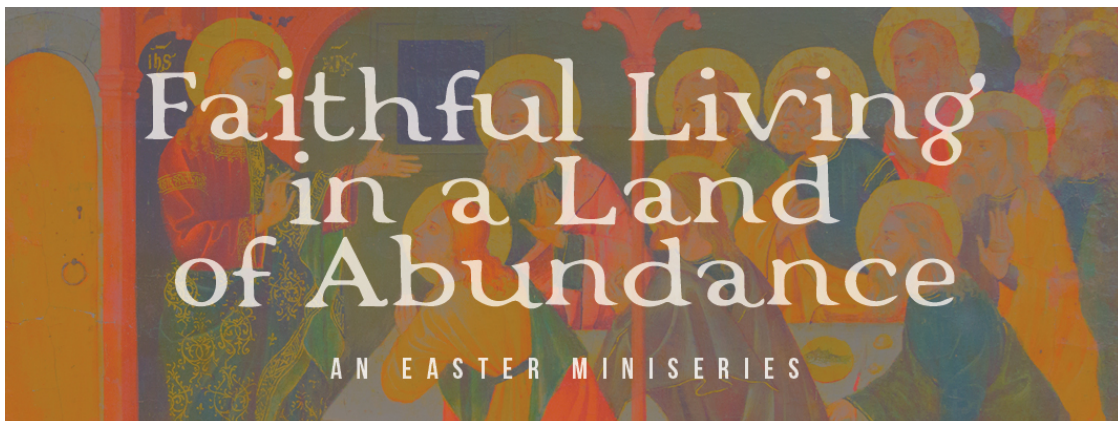

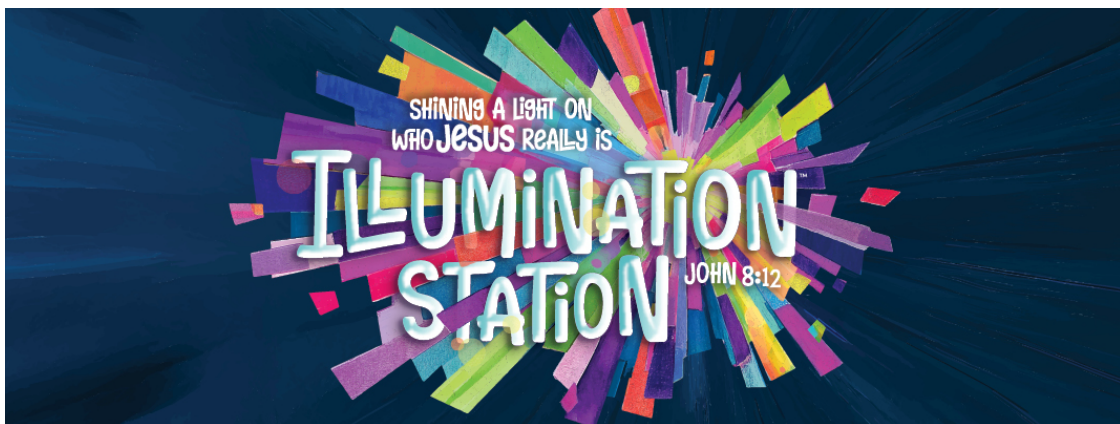
## **AgeReady: A Tool for Families to Plan End of Life** **May 28 | 11:30 a.m. | Heritage Hall**

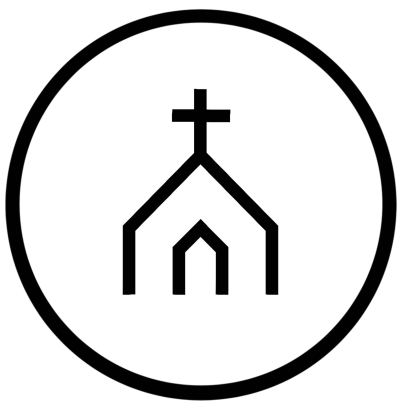

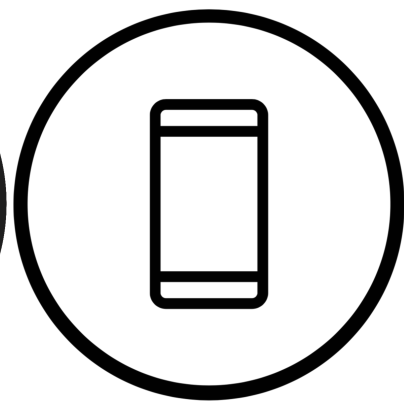
