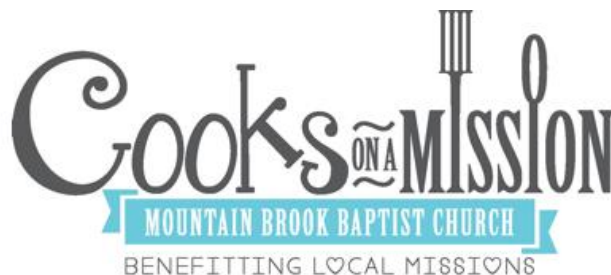

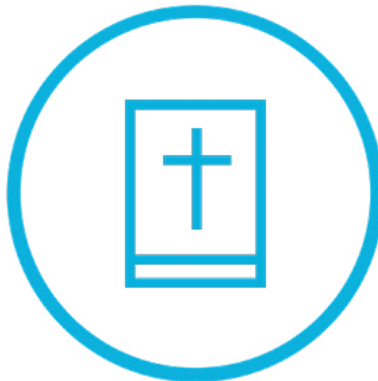


## Meet Our New Member: Lara Dean

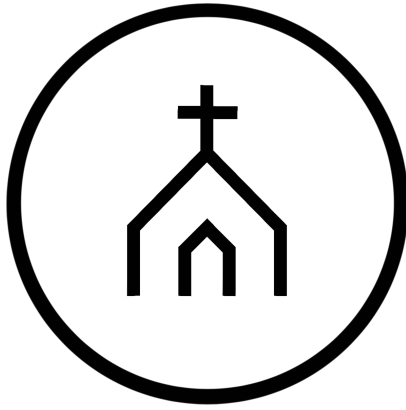

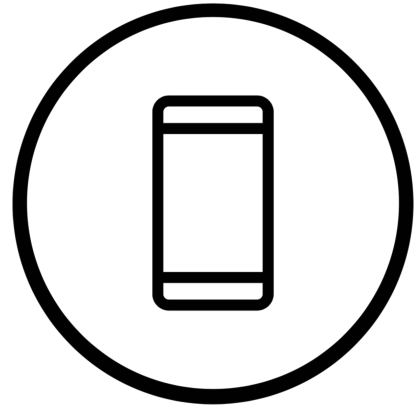
