Sunday, October 25 | 4-6 p.m. | MBBC Lower Lot

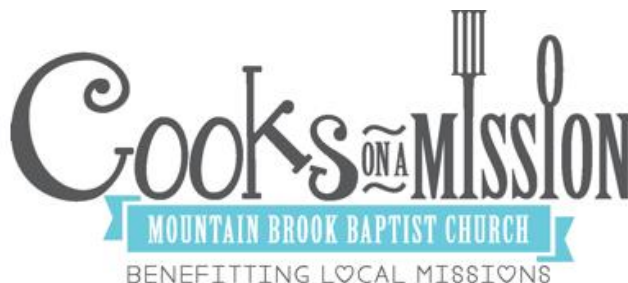
