# First Sunday of Worship in the Gym & 80<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Celebration

This Sunday, September 8 is a significant day in the life of our church, as we move to worship in the gym while our Sanctuary undergoes renovations for our Renewal building project.

This date also marks the 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Mountain Brook Baptist Church, which we will commemorate that morning in both worship services. Make plans to tour the renewed spaces of our building (Student Ministry Space on fourth floor, Adult Education spaces on third floor and 2A floor) before or after Sunday School (between 9:30-10 a.m. and 11-11:30 a.m.).

While we are worshipping in the gym, the valet will be stationed outside the gym to park and retrieve cars. For those who need assistance to get to Sunday School from the gym (and back to their vehicles), we will be operating golf cart shuttles from 9:50-10:10 a.m. and then 10:50-11:10 a.m., which will pick up at the back of the gym and drop people off on the Sanctuary side of the church off Montevallo Road.






