Located in Pointe Noire, Congo, Mwana Villages is a refuge and shelter that seeks to provide full-time, conscientious orphan care to children from violent and abusive backgrounds. Through its committed and trustworthy staff of over 50, Mwana strives for family permanency, whether it is through family reunification, adoption, or children finding a permanent home at the Mwana Refuge. Since the Refuge opened in 2012, 65% of families have permanently been reunited or preserved, 20% of children have safely and successfully been adopted, and 15% of children have found a permanent home in the Mwana family.
