## • Promote Relationship

- o Introduce yourself to anyone you don't know.
- Learn names and try to remember hobbies.
- O Share your own answers & be vulnerable.
- o These students look up to you, even when they don't show it.

#### • Have a Plan

- Opening Questions, Main Discussion & The Big Idea, Reflect, Live it Out & The Big Idea (Again!), Closing Prayer.
- o Don't let any one section of a study dominate your time.
- Know your dismissal time

## • Don't Rush

- Allow multiple answers to your questions, even if someone 'gets it right.'
- Even if you finish early, don't dismiss them. It disturbs other groups.
  Use the time to learn about your student's week ahead, hobbies etc.

# • The "Art of Asking Questions"

- Ask open-ended questions.
  - After reading a scripture, always ask a really open question.
  - Don't answer the question yourself until after others have answered.
  - Just because you have an answer on your page, doesn't mean it is the only answer!
- o Extend Answers by using follow up questions like
  - Tell me more about that.
  - What did you mean when you said...
- o Encourage More Answers by saying...
  - What else?
  - Someone else what do you think?
  - Two more answers before we move on.
  - Someone who hasn't answered yet, what do you think about...
  - Restate the question.

#### • The Soft Skills

- Being in front of others is a little uncomfortable, but that is NATURAL. Don't worry about it.
- o Eye contact.
- o Silence is a good thing.
- o It is good to say "I don't know."
